
No. of Programmes in 2022



Brunei Darussalam has long emphasized the importance of quality education to drive socio-economic development and foster social stability. Seven (7) main forest types namely Mixed Dipterocarp Forest (MDF), Peat Swamp Forest, Freshwater Swamp Forest, Mangrove Forest, Heath (Kerangas) Forest, Montane Forest, and Beach Forest make up 72% of the total land area. The government is actively working to extend the areas gazetted as forest reserves to 55% of the total land area, which currently stands at 41%.

Heart of Borneo Initiative

 There is a need to do more research on country's biodiversity to understand how they function and their significance, thus leading to their sustainable utilization, conservation and management.
